Many women and young women have experienced sexual assault at some time in their life

Sexual Assault is defined as:

Unwanted behaviour of a sexual nature directed towards a person which makes that person feel uncomfortable, distressed, frightened, threatened or harmed: in circumstances where that person has not freely agreed, consented or is incapable of consenting to that behaviour.

Community attitudes towards violence against women often blame the survivors/victims.

At CASV we believe that survivors/ victims are never to blame. The perpetrator is always responsible. Sexual assault is a crime.

Services Provided Counselling

- Free confidential counselling to all women, and young women 12 years and over who have experienced recent, past and/or childhood sexual assault.
- · Counselling is provided by tertiary qualified trauma-informed specialists.
- Counsellors will work with you at your pace to explore your individual counselling needs. You do not have to talk about anything that you are not comfortable or ready to discuss.

Group Work

A number of groups are held throughout the year by experienced facilitators.

Education and Training

Information, education and resources are provided to the community.

School Outreach Program

Some availability for outreach counselling and educational workshops in high schools.

Information & Referral

- Information and referral about the legal process, health and medical issues.
- Information for friends and family of women and young women who have been sexually assaulted.
- Information and support to other service providers.

CASV believes that victims/ survivors have the right to:

- · Be believed.
- Be heard and supported in a safe environment.
- · Have control over their choices.
- · Be given information about options.
- Have their confidentiality and privacy respected.
- Be treated with respect, dignity and understanding.
- Communicate in their own language, with a qualified confidential interpreter if necessary.
